Sometimes it is the small moments in a dialogue that create a depth central to your dialogue partner. This workshop introduces co-creative and value-based dialogues that, at their best, enable clients to see themselves in a new light.

Transformative dialogues provide an anchor point and a sense of integrity in how individuals understand themselves and others, and strengthen how they act in the world. This creates moments of symmetry, where both parties, or a whole group, are involved in the developmental process. The session closes with a live demonstration of a collaborative dialogue that includes all participants.
